Manga High	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Go to https://www.mangahigh.com/en-gb/ and click the Log In button.2. Enter the log in details provided to you last October which were stuck into your Homework Journal (if this has been lost please or if you haven't received log in details email liam.murray@scoilnaomheltin.ie)3. Complete the assigned games before the deadline (the games will require you to try a number of times before you succeed - don't give up!)4. Students are free to complete other games in Manga High but one particular challenge will be assigned each day
Duolingo Suggestion: use earphones or a headset for this as listening is required.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Go to https://www.duolingo.com/welcome and select "School" and continue2. Next Select "Regular - 10 mins/day"3. Select the "Know Some Irish Already" option and take the "Placement Test" (don't be discouraged if the placement test only unlocks a small percentage of the course - if it unlocked close to all the course you would be fluent already!)4. Complete the registration by creating a profile (age, name, email account and password required)5. Now everyday students can log in and improve their Irish through challenges. Use the tips button on each course to learn some new words before trying the challenges.

Instructions for Accessing Online Books

To access 2nd Class Literacy program (Fun at the Circus and Skills Book) follow these steps;

1. Go to www.gillexplore.ie/products
2. On this web page there will be 3 drop down menus at top of page; "All titles" , "All subjects" , "All class levels"
3. Set these drop down menus to "Primary Titles" , "English" , "2ndClass" respectively.
4. 4 options will appear for you. The 2nd Class Skills Book will be the first of these.
5. Click on the Skills Book icon and this will bring you to a page where you will be able to access all relevant resources for 2nd Class by simply clicking on them.
